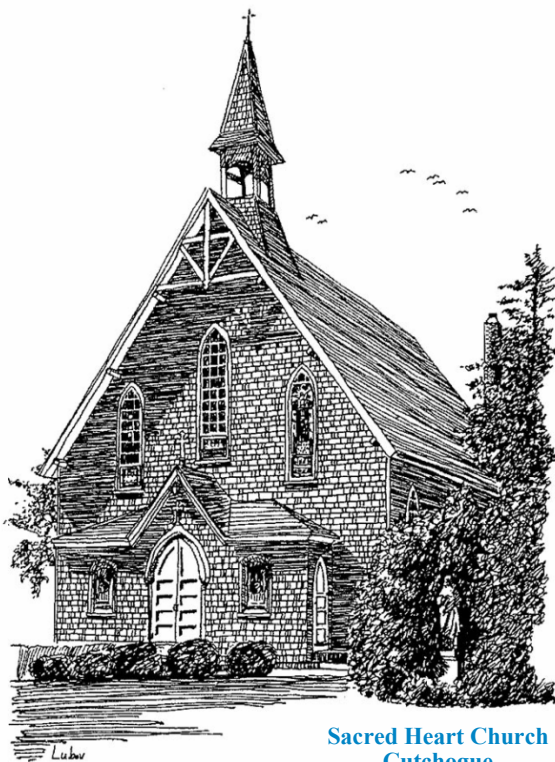

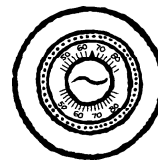

STEWARDSHIP SAINT OF THE MONTH SAINT CECILIA

Legend says St. Cecilia was a young Christian woman who converted her husband and his brother, both of whom were martyred for their faith. It was a dangerous time to be a Christian, and St. Cecilia, too, was put to death.

It may be that this early martyr was a musician. Images of St. Cecilia often include a viola or small organ. She has been acclaimed as the patron saint of sacred music since the fifteenth century. St. Augustine urged, "Let us sing a new song not with our lips but with our lives... Every one of us tries to discover how to sing to God."

How do I "sing to God?" What gifts and talents do I have to offer to the Lord? Are gratitude and good stewardship the testimony, not only of my lips, but of my life?

THANKSGIVING DAY MASS



Thanksgiving is a time of reflection and a time to be thankful for all the wonderful gifts we receive each day, no matter how simple or how grand.

This Thanksgiving Day you are invited to take time out and come to the Thanksgiving Day Mass, 9:00 a.m. at Our Lady of Good Counsel Church, to pray with us and thank Our Lord God for all He has given us. Families are especially encouraged to participate.

We are asking all who attend this Mass to bring with them a can of meat, vegetable or soup to help replenish the pantry shelves of the North Fork Parish Outreach. Items that we really need at our North Fork Parish Outreach are: jelly, mac & cheese, pancake mix & syrup, instant coffee, red and black beans and items for personal hygiene. We will not have our usual collection at the Offertory, instead we ask everyone, at the offertory, to process up to the Sanctuary as we do at Communion and deposit the canned goods in the baskets provided for this purpose. If you cannot bring a canned item or you forget it at home, we are also accepting monetary donations to be placed in the Parish Outreach Box, between the food baskets.

The Blessing of Thanksgiving Food will take place immediately after the offertory. Those wishing to have Thanksgiving food blessed are asked to come up to the front of the church at this time with their food. Once Fr. Joe has blessed the food, please return to your seat, and Mass will continue.

Together, let’s give thanks to our God who has given us so much to be thankful for.

**NOTICE TO PARISHIONERS
OF SACRED HEART PARISH
Cutchogue, NY**

Monsignor Joseph Staudt has requested Catholic Cemeteries of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Rockville Centre, Inc. (CemCo) to manage the Cemetery of the Sacred Heart. The parish will continue to maintain ownership of the cemetery. This transfer of services for the management of the cemetery is scheduled to take place October 26, 2018.

CemCo's Service Agreement for the management of the cemetery will provide the required staffing for the sale of plots, arrangement of interments, and receive any question and/or comments. CemCo will continue to use outside services for the necessary labor to bury the dead and landscaping during the growing season.

Catholic Cemeteries of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Rockville Centre, Inc. recently became a separate and distinct entity from the diocese. We currently own and operate four cemetery sites; Cemetery of the Holy Rood in Westbury, Queen of All Saints Cemeteries in Central Islip, Holy Sepulchre Cemetery in Coram, and our newest site under construction, Queen of Peace Cemetery in Old Westbury which is scheduled to open late 2020. In addition, we also manage five other parish cemeteries; St. Boniface Cemetery in Elmont, St. Francis de Sales Cemetery in Patchogue, St. John of God in Central Islip, St. Patrick Cemetery in Brookville and St. John the Evangelist Cemetery in Riverhead. Following year of planning and discussion, beginning October 26, 2018 the Cemetery of the Sacred Heart will be cared for as well.

Starting October 26, the staff located at Holy Sepulchre Cemetery in Coram will be your contact for any cemetery matters. Please call 631-732-3460 for assistance.

We will continue offering each other the Sign of Peace during Mass. This will be left to each parishioner's discretion. Please be understanding if a parishioner does not want to shake hands during the Sign of Peace.

We are asking for your help as well; if you are feeling ill, please consider staying home. It is not a sin in this instance to miss Mass, it's actually an act of love and consideration for one's fellow parishioners. This is, perhaps, the most effective way of preventing the spread of disease.

Coughing and sneezing into the crook of your elbow also helps.
