

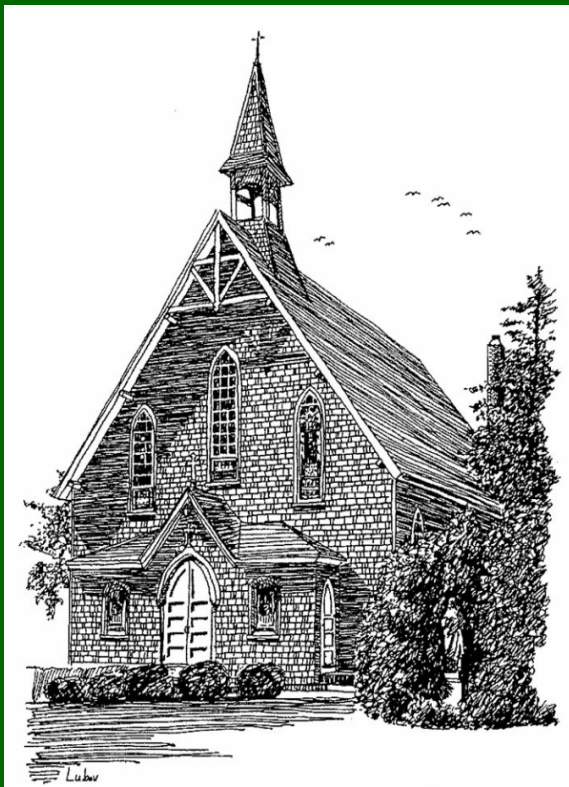

NORTH FORK PARISH OUTREACH UPDATE

This update always ends with "We at the Outreach are privileged to serve our neighbors in need," which is a variation on the words of Giovanni Guareschi who once said, "When you share your last crust of bread with a beggar, you mustn't behave as if you were throwing a bone to a dog. You must give humbly, and thank him for allowing you to have a part in his hunger."

We at the Outreach - the volunteers at the Thrift Shop who make it possible to fund the non-food needs of those in crisis, the volunteers who cheerfully serve those who visit the Pantry, the core volunteers who staff the office, and our coordinator who directs the Outreach and sets the moral tone for all who reach out to our local poor and marginalized - these and all (including you who donate groceries to our Parish Food Drives) who support the Outreach efforts are especially conscious of our many blessings as we head into Thanksgiving and the holiday season. May our gratitude inspire us to increase our generosity.

In October, the Outreach Pantry distributed 219 bags of groceries to 57 households, this total consisting of 164 individuals of all ages and races. Our Parish October Food Drive contributed 41 bags and \$786 to the Pantry.

THANKSGIVING DAY MASS

This Thanksgiving Day you are invited to take time out and come to the Thanksgiving Day Mass, 9:00 a.m. at Our Lady of Good Counsel Church, to pray with us and thank Our Lord God for all He has given us. Families are especially encouraged to participate.

We are asking all who attend this Mass to bring with them a can of meat, vegetable or soup to help replenish the pantry shelves of the North Fork Parish Outreach. Items that we really need at our North Fork Parish Outreach are: jelly, mac & cheese, pancake mix & syrup, instant coffee, red and black beans and items for personal hygiene. We will not have our usual collection at the Offertory, instead we ask everyone, at the offertory, to process up to the Sanctuary as we do at Communion and deposit the canned goods in the baskets provided for this purpose. If you cannot bring a canned item or you forget it at home, we are also accepting monetary donations to be placed in the Parish Outreach Box, between the food baskets.

The Blessing of Thanksgiving Food will take place immediately after the offertory. Those wishing to have Thanksgiving food blessed are asked to come up to the front of the church at this time with their food. Once Fr. Joe has blessed the food, please return to your seat, and Mass will continue.

Together, let's give thanks to our God who has given us so much to be thankful for.

Catholic School education started. The parish hall was utilized for classrooms containing the original student body, children in grades 1 through 3. The school building which would house grades 1 through 8 was completed in 1959. In the early years, more students were enrolled in Sacred Heart School than in the parish religious education program. There was no tuition at that time and parents contributed to the building of the school were promised that they would never have to pay tuition. While this was a very worthwhile and commendable attitude, it placed a burden on the parish.

RECEIVING COMMUNION IN FLU TIMES

Flu season runs from October to May, with most cases happening from late December to early March.

In an effort to keep everyone healthy you will see that cup ministers will NOT be offering the Precious Blood at Mass.

Please know that all Eucharistic Ministers use hand sanitizer both before and after distributing Communion.

We will continue offering each other the Sign of Peace during Mass. This will be left to each parishioner's discretion. Please be understanding if a parishioner does not want to shake hands during the Sign of Peace.

We are asking for your help as well; if you are feeling ill, please consider staying home. It is not a sin in this instance to miss Mass, it's actually an act of love and consideration for one's fellow parishioners. This is, perhaps, the most effective way of preventing the spread of disease.

Coughing and sneezing into the crook of your elbow also helps.
