

CATHOLIC COMMUNICATIONS CAMPAIGN


This weekend, our parish is taking up a special Diocesan Collection for the Catholic Communications Campaign.

NORTH FORK PARISH OUTREACH UPDATE

Last month, an unholy fire devastated Paris' Notre Dame Cathedral, and immediately donations poured out to rebuild the cathedral. In some marginalized lives, an unforeseen, unexpected devastation also occurs, and it is good to know that our Parish Outreach helps rebuild through food, counseling and other support. This month through Outreach guidance and assistance, Sarah is not facing homelessness but will start a new job in a new Section 8 subsidized apartment, rebuilding a life formerly in ruin. Please remember her and all those who struggle to lift themselves up again.

In April, the Outreach Pantry distributed 213 bags of groceries to 50 households, this total consisting of 136 individuals of all ages and races. Our April Food Drive and Holy Thursday Food Collection contributed 73 bags of groceries, \$100 in gift cards, and \$2,315 to the Pantry.

We at the Outreach are privileged to serve our neighbors in need.

I am happy to say he is working, has his own place and even invited me to come by if I am ever in the neighborhood. This is what Maureen's Haven is all about, working with the homeless, helping them get through tough times. Temporary housing for those who are poor, alone and on their own, helping them get back into society, we try to make a difference. Yes, sometimes we do all of that without realizing it. The best part is what we get back from them, a simple smile to just knowing collectively, we helped someone and made a difference.

Thank you again from the bottom of my heart for your time, talent, treasure and emotional support. Keep doing what you have been doing. For the younger adults in our church community, WE NEED YOU! To help continue this ministry. Maureen's Haven is the type of ministry you can give as little or as much of your time as you wish.
