



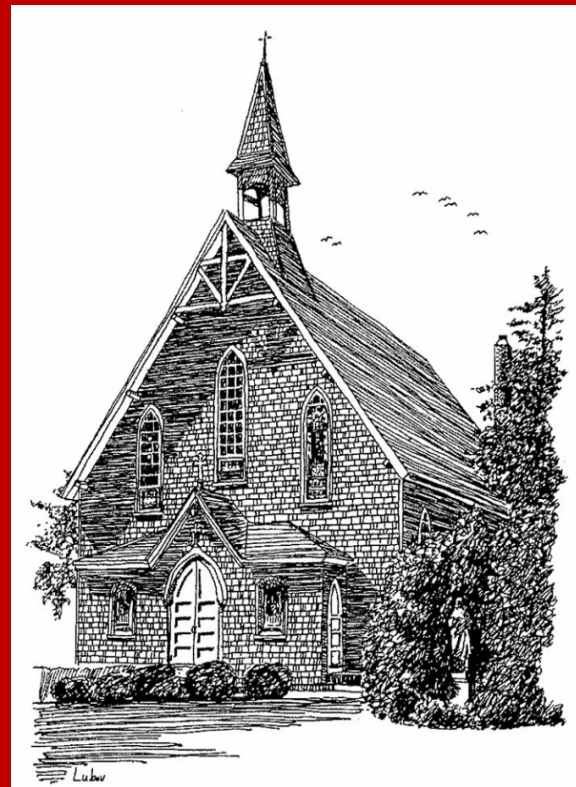

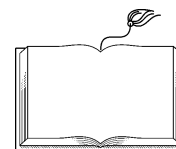
BOXED SETS OF DONATION ENVELOPES

In the middle of the 1970's, inflation affected the nation as well as the parish. The school struggled to keep its doors open. The new principal, Sr. Beatrice Barry, C.S.J., accepted the challenge of keeping Catholic school education alive on the North Fork. In June 1975, St. Agnes School in Greenport closed its doors. Families wishing a Catholic school environment sent their children to Sacred Heart School. This increased the enrollment by 50%. But the parish and school still struggled. Sr. Beatrice and Fr. Henry devised a strategy to gain financial support of the other three parishes on the North Fork and the parish on Shelter Island.

Every Sunday, the Catholic Mass is televised at 7:00 a.m. on channel 10 and at 8:00 a.m. on channel 48.

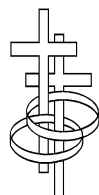

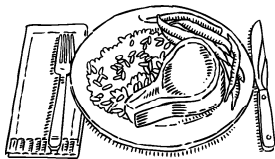
